BVU POLICY

Buena Vista University will award up to \$40,000 in scholarships annually to students enrolled in our Online Programs. To be eligible for a scholarship of up to \$400 per semester, students must be fulltime and a new student at BVU. **The maximum yearly award is \$1,200 and lifetime maximum award is \$1,600 per student.**

New Applicants are required to:

- Submit the PTK scholarship application, PTK membership documentation, and application for admission. The documents must arrive in the BVU office prior to the start date of the student's first BVU term.
- Be a member in good standing of Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society at the time of their community college enrollment and submit documentation of that membership. This application contains a section for verification from the chapter advisor or community college Registrar.
- Applicants must have graduated with an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Applied Studies, Associate of Professional Studies, or Associate of Applied Arts degree.
- Transcripts from all colleges attended must be received and official evaluation of all transcripts must be completed by the end of the applicant's first semester or the award will be rescinded.
- Students who have earned a previous bachelor's degree and international students are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Submit the FAFSA for each year of eligibility.

Renewal process and GPA requirement:

- PTK recipients will automatically be considered for renewal for the next consecutive academic year.
- PTK recipients must maintain a BVU cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

A student's BVU cumulative GPA will be checked after grades have posted for Term 4. Those students who do not have a 3.0 BVU CGPA following Term 4 will be given Term 5 to bring their BVU CGPA back to a 3.0 and they will be allowed to keep the scholarship during Terms 5 and 6. If the BVU CGPA is not restored by the end of Term 5, a student's financial aid award letter for Term 1 will be adjusted removing the scholarship and the student will not be eligible for future PTK Scholarship funds.

Awarding parameters:

- Full-time per semester.....\$400
- Three Quarter Time\$300
- Halftime per semester\$200
- Less than Half.....\$100
- Applications will be reviewed continuously throughout the academic year for upcoming terms.
- Awards will be made on a rolling, first-come, first-served basis until the funds are expended.

Appeals:

A student may appeal termination of this scholarship caused by personal illness or injury, loss of a family member, or other circumstances beyond their control. The appeal should be submitted in writing to the Director of Enrollment and Student Success who will confer with the Vice President of Extended University Programs and will provide the final decision in writing to the student.
